- Plan and implement 8-12 weeks of age-appropriate projects and activities in an area of focus that fits within Willowbrook's mission at select TTSD schools
- Create material supply list within allotted budget and communicate needs clearly with the Program Director
- Engage and guide children in activities designed build creative skills and encourage a sense of discovery
- Ensure a safe and welcoming environment; promote a positive and inclusive community that encourages cooperation and values diversity and self-expression
